STATEMENT OF FEES

The tuition fees shown below are based on your eligibility for Government funding. Concession fee rates are available to eligible students who hold a Health Care Card, Pension concession card, Veterans gold card or for those who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. Full Fee and Diploma students are ineligible for the concession rate. You must provide proof of concession eligibility at the time of enrolment to receive the concession fee rate. *Yearly Amenities Fee

A pro-rata rate is calculated for the Yearly Amenities Fee if you commence after March 30th. The Yearly Amenities Fee is due each January that you are on course, regardless of the month you anticipate completing the course. If course completion is expected after January, the annual fee will need to be paid (read the pre-enrolment handbook for further details).

How do I pay my fees?

Once you have enrolled, you will be issued a Tax Invoice detailing your fees, less any credit transfers, and the due date for payment. Fees can be paid by Cheque (addressed to Marjorie Milner College), through Direct Debit, EFTPOS or by Credit Card (2% surcharge applies). All fees are displayed in Australian Dollars.

When do I pay my fees?

Tuition charges are paid at the beginning of training and the beginning of each year. Fee for service students will be required to pay no more than \$1000 on the day of commencement. They will then be required to pay no more than \$1000 per month until the full cost of the course is paid. Students will be provided with a fee schedule with breakdowns of amounts.

Am I eligible for a refund?

For a full refund on fees, a withdrawal form and refund form must be given to Marjorie Milner College within 30 days of commencement. As noted on the website, the Yearly Education Amenities Fee is non-refundable and is forfeit in the event of withdrawal.
